
## **Internet settings**

## I have an iPhone, how do I setup mobile internet?


1. Tap **Settings > Cellular**

4. Tap **APN** and enter **YESINTERNET** 



To finalise the changes, **Power off your iPhone** and switch it **back on**.


**Note**: Some iPhones may work without setting up an APN. This will only require you to **Reset Settings (under Cellular Data)** for the APN to be back on its default settings (i.e. iPhone 8, iPhone 6/6Plus)
