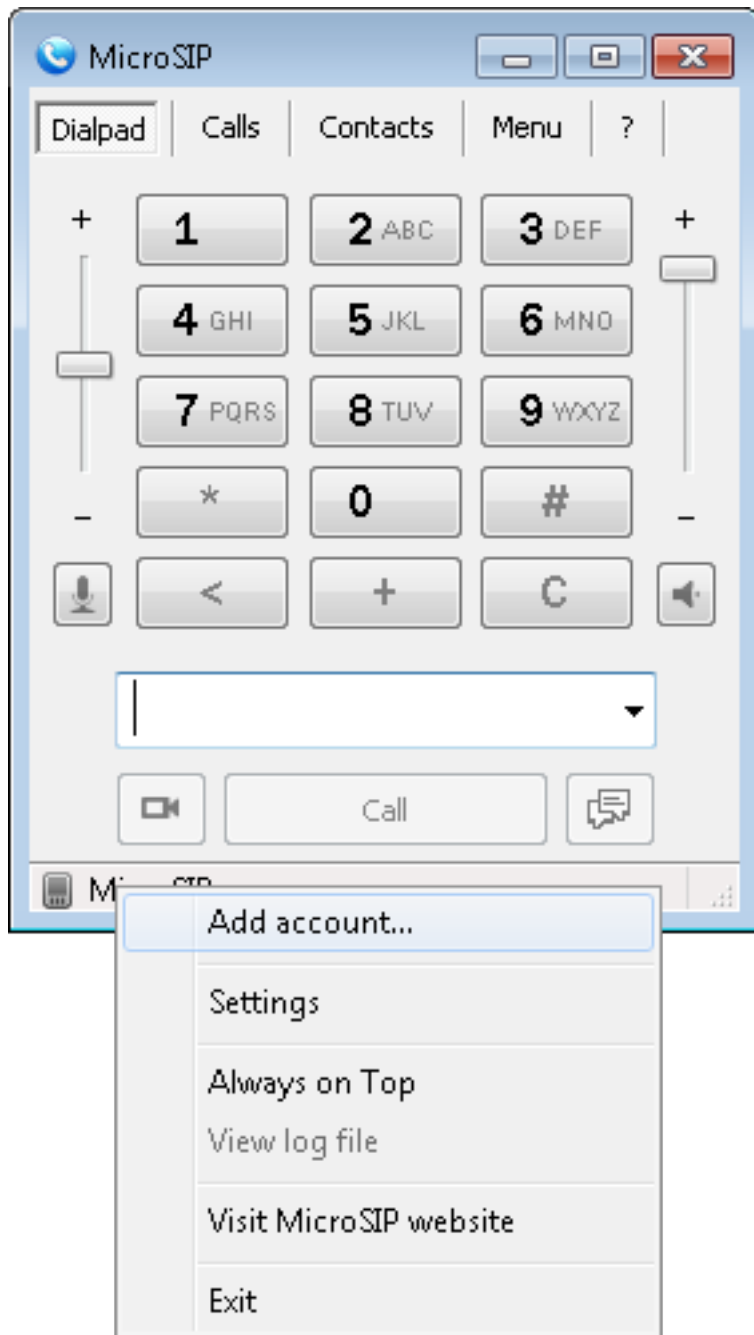


MicroSIP for Windows Setup

1. Download MicroSIP [here](#) and install it.



2. Right mouse click on the "MicroSIP" icon, as shown below and select "Add account".

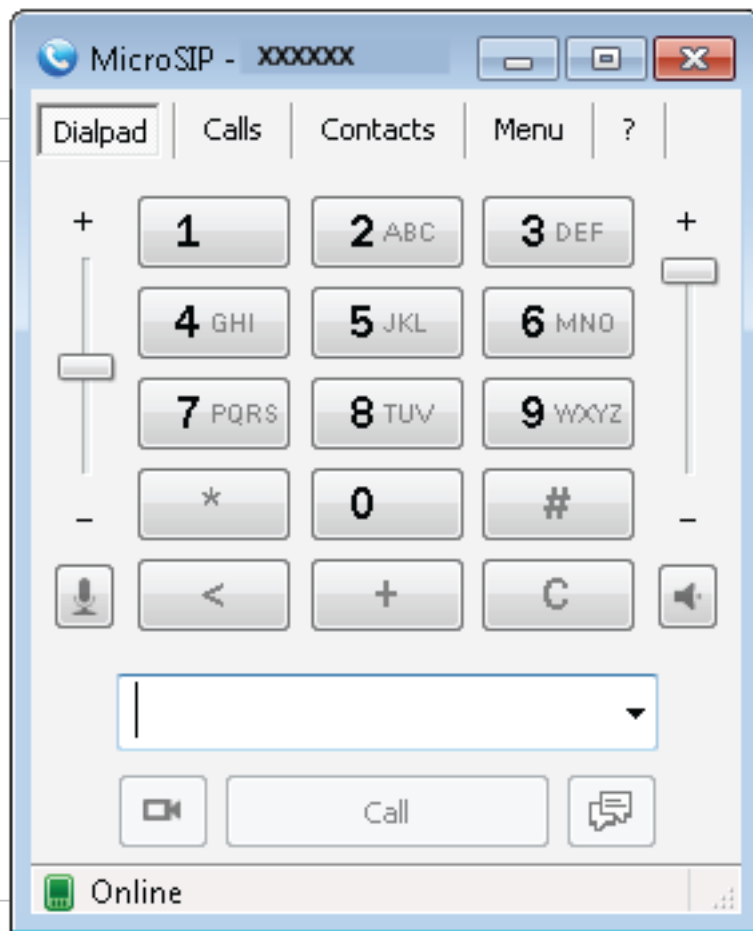
