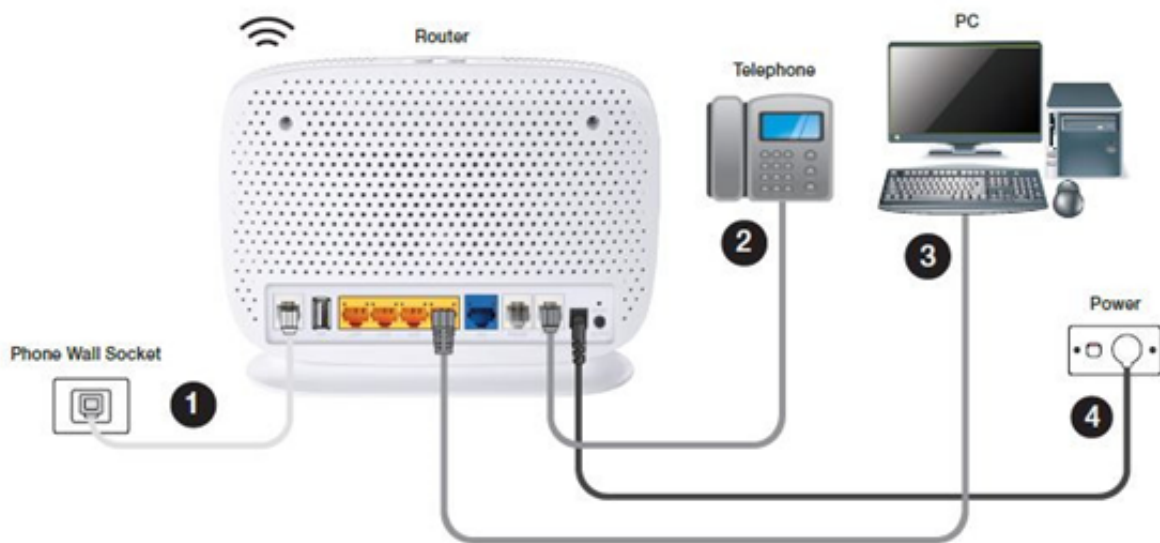


Setting up your FTTN/B connection



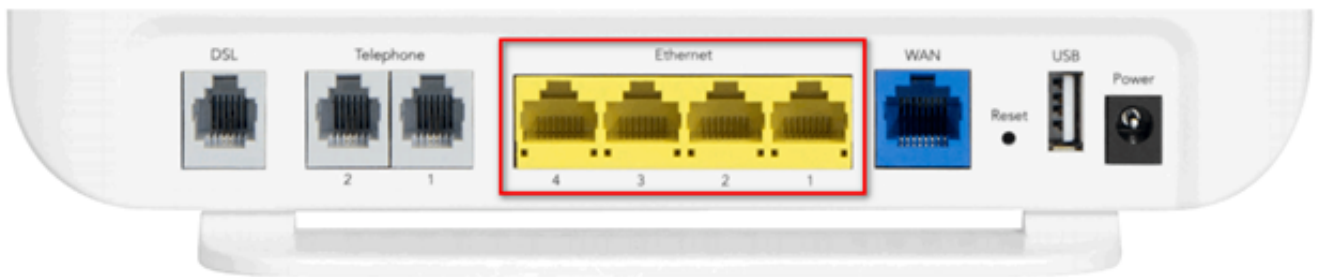
1. Using your gray telephone cord, connect the main telephone socket to the DSL port on the modem.



2. Connect the black power cord to the black port on the modem and the other end to the power outlet.



3. You can then connect your devices to one of the yellow LAN ports to access the internet.



4. For wireless setup, please use the wireless security card for the WIFI network name and the password which can be found inside the modem box. You can also find it on the sticker on the base of the modem.
